Statement	Tri-Board Student Transportation Services may provide transportation to and from school for a student for school programs:	
	 Who is enrolled by the Boards, including all International Students Who is traveling to a school within the Board's jurisdiction where the Boards are providing education services to students from another Board Who is traveling to a school operated by another Board to which the Boards provides educational services. It is the policy of the Boards to provide transportation in accordance with <u>Ministry of Education and Training guidelines</u> and the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u>, subject to provisions of the Education Act and regulations. It is the prime objective of the Boards to ensure the safety of all transported students and not only to maintain but also to improve the level of education and to meet the aim of equalized education opportunity for all students in the jurisdiction. 	
Procedure	 Safety Rules for Students: Parents are responsible for the safety and conduct of their children to the pick-up point, until the children board the bus, and when they leave the bus on their return home Arrive at your stop 5 minutes prior to pick up time. Wait 2 steps back from the road. Dress properly for the weather. Do not cross the road until the bus is stopped, the driver has turned on the upper alternating red signal lights and extended the school bus stop arm. Look both ways and wait for the driver's signal.
