Statement	<p>When inclement weather interferes with the safe transportation of students, school buses may be delayed or cancelled.</p> <p>Tri-Board Student Transportation Services encourages all parents/guardians to subscribe to our email notification system to receive up-to-date information on delays and cancellations of their children’s bus routes. Tri-Board also posts delays and cancellation to Twitter under @BusDelayNCancel.</p> <p>In the event of an all-day bus cancellation, parents/guardians who choose to transport their children to school are also responsible for afternoon pick up.</p>	
Procedure	<p>Cancellations may come in the form of a general cancellation where all buses are cancelled or the cancellation may only affect one or more specific schools or school zones.</p> <p>If a bus is cancelled in the morning due to ice or snow, it will not operate in the afternoon.</p> <p>If a bus is cancelled in the morning due to fog and it clears by noon, the bus will operate in the afternoon</p> <p>Early Dismissal due to Inclement Weather: Inclement weather conditions sometimes occur after students have arrived at school. A decision to remain in school or to dismiss early may be made by the Director(s) of Education in co-operation with Tri-Board. If there is a decision for buses to leave early, bus operators and radio stations will be contacted by Tri-Board personnel.</p>
