Statement	To ensure the safety of students on buses for home-to-school transportation, certain conditions govern the transporting of some specific items.	
Procedure	<p>Skates: Ice and In-line skates shall be covered by guards, tied together and carried in a durable bag. The skates shall be placed on the floor of the bus at the student's feet.</p> <p>Sporting Equipment: skis and poles, hockey equipment, curling brooms, skateboards, golf clubs, etc. may not be transported on a school bus.</p> <p>Musical Instruments & School Projects: musical instruments may be transported in their cases only and shall be kept on the student's lap while the student is on the bus. Similarly, projects should also be kept on the student's lap. If instruments or projects are too large, parents/guardians are responsible for transportation.</p> <p>Animals: no animals will be transported on a school bus whether caged or not, with the exception of service animals.</p>
