<b>Statement</b>	It is the responsibility of Tri-Board Student Transportation Services to service identified hazard zones.	
<b>Procedure</b>	<p>Factors contributing to a hazard designation include but are not limited to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Railway crossings</li><li>• Congested traffic at shopping and or business areas</li><li>• Requirement to cross multi-lane highway</li><li>• Requirement to cross a municipal bridge that is deemed hazardous</li><li>• Expected heavy traffic conditions at various times during the day</li><li>• Presence or absence of traffic control signals</li><li>• An uncontrolled intersection and areas with no sidewalks or shoulders</li></ul> <p>Temporary stop locations may also be established in construction zones, flooded areas and areas with downed power lines. Hazard concerns are reviewed as required.</p>
