Statement	The Student Identification Tag Program is a quick, safe, effective means for all stakeholders to help protect our most vulnerable students. Tags provided by Tri-Board Student Transportation Services are available upon request at the school.	
Procedure	<p>An identification tag is placed on the handgrip on the top of a student's backpack.</p> <p>Met at Stop</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All students with a purple tag on their backpack will not be let off the bus by the driver without a parent/guardian or designate present. <p>Medical</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All students with an identified medical concern are provided with a red tag to notify the driver that there should be a Medical Release of Information Form on the bus as completed by parent/guardian. This form is available at the school. <p>Transfer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All elementary students who transfer from one bus to another will be provided with a blue tag for drivers to recognize they are a transfer student.
