

# Reports of Unsafe Driving

## Statement

School bus drivers are employed by Operators who will be notified of any concerns/allegations of unsafe driving and/or behaviour brought to Tri-Board's attention. Operators will investigate the allegations as soon as possible and report their findings to Tri-Board. Serious, substantiated allegations where students and/or the public may be in immediate danger will be treated in the same manner per the Accident/Incident Procedure. Serious allegations include possible impaired driving, erratic behaviour, and/or a physical or mental health crisis.

## Procedure

Upon receiving an allegation of unsafe driving, Tri-Board will notify the Operator immediately and request they investigate. If the run is in service and the allegation is considered serious and substantiated, the Operator may consider sending personnel to meet the bus and/or calling emergency services. If necessary, a spare bus may be dispatched to complete the run and a delay posted to BusPlanner.

If the Operator is unable to investigate, Tri-Board will act as their designate.
