Statement

Tri-Board Student Transportation Services authorizes the use of technological systems on school buses to promote student safety and efficiency of service. In the event of a reported or observed incident, this technology may be used to assist in the investigation of the incident.

Procedure

Automatic Vehicle Locator (AVL)

Tri-Board requires all route vehicles to use approved, working Automatic Vehicle Locator (AVLs). Data collected through AVLs is used by Tri-Board to track route schedules, vehicle speeds and stop locations, ensure route efficiencies, and use of equipment required under the [Highway Traffic Act](#).

Video Surveillance

Video surveillance installed on school buses will only be reviewed at the request of the principal and/or Tri-Board administrative team and will be solely for the purpose of addressing an incident.

Notice signs will be installed on buses with video surveillance systems, in accordance with the notification requirements of the [Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act](#). Signs will be prominently displayed so that the public has reasonable and adequate warning that surveillance is or may be operating.
