

Temporary Transportation for Students in Extenuating Circumstances

Procedure 214

Statement

As per the Transportation Policy section 8.0 –*Temporary Transportation for Students in Extenuating Circumstances*, Tri-Board recognizes there may be extenuating circumstances facing a student that may affect their need for transportation temporarily. The Circumstances must relate to the student specifically.

A parent/guardian who believes their student should be supervised while travelling to/from or waiting at the bus stop, but who cannot provide this supervision is not considered an extenuating circumstance and will not be considered under this procedure.

Procedure

Parents/guardians must submit requests for transportation for students in extenuating circumstances to the school using the [Extenuating Circumstance Transportation Application](#) to the school for approval. Principals must sign this form acknowledging conditions which create a need for transportation prior to the form being submitted to Tri-Board.

Accommodation of Students in Extenuating Circumstances

Similarly to the conditions outlined in *AP 205 Courtesy Transportation*, Tri-Board will make every attempt to accommodate the student without incurring additional costs. Depending on the circumstances of the request, other measures may be taken. If approval of the request results in additional costs being incurred by Tri-Board, the request must be approved by the School Board.

Review of Extenuating Circumstances

Extenuating Circumstance transportation is designed to be temporary and will be given an end date. The circumstances will be reviewed prior to the end date, and transportation will either be eliminated or extended. A new application may be required.
